Creation and Mandate

The CLSU Open University was created on August 29, 1997 by virtue of Board of Regents Resolution No. 50-97. Its mandate is to generate and offer education opportunities through various degree, non-degree and short-term programs. Its target clientele consists of individuals aspiring for higher education, but who are unable to avail of the traditional mode of instruction.

Vision

to be a model open and distance learning enterprise in Southeast Asia in the next ten years.

Mission

to provide its clients with opportunities to acquire credentials and formal qualifications for lifelong learning in today's knowledge society.

Mode of Instruction

OU courses are delivered in the distance learning/online mode using interactive learning modules and internet-based/computer-aided materials.

Students use especially packaged learning modules. Learning modules are available in the Open University website: www.openuni-clsu.edu.ph or picked up from the OU offices.

An important element of distance education is the tutorial session. Tutorial sessions provide students with the opportunity to interact with their tutors and peers. Online learning is supported by internet chats and blackboard discussions to optimize learning.

Student performance is assessed through assignments, exercises and activities, and supervised sit-down examinations.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Prospective enrollees should be bachelor's/ master's degree holders and computer literate. They must submit the following requirements to the Open University:

1. Accomplished application forms;
2. Original Transcript of Records;
3. Two letters of recommendation from current supervisors or former professors.
4. Two identical 2" x 2" colored pictures; and
5. Application fee.

Foreigners from non-English speaking countries should show proof of proficiency in the English language..

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Regular Application:

1. Secure Forms 1, 2, & 3 personally from the OU or from the OU website. Accomplish the forms and submit the same to the OU Registrar together with the other admission requirements.
2. Pay application fee personally to the CLSU OU or send payment to the OU through the Land Bank of the Philippines (Muñoz, Nueva Ecija Branch) through Acct. No. 2962-1006-89. Fax receipt to Tel No. (044)-456-5242 or send it to the OU as e-mail annex.

Online Application:

2. Applicants may also send the admission requirements to the CLSU OU through pouch service.
